Helping Florida cats and dogs in need is our number one priority, rescuing those who are at risk of euthanasia in other shelters due to lack of space, time, or resources. We believe that love saves lives, and every animal deserves to feel loved and valued.

FLORIDA FOCUSED:

We partnered with **33 Florida shelters and organizations** to take in cats and dogs in need. We do not transfer in animals from out of state.
